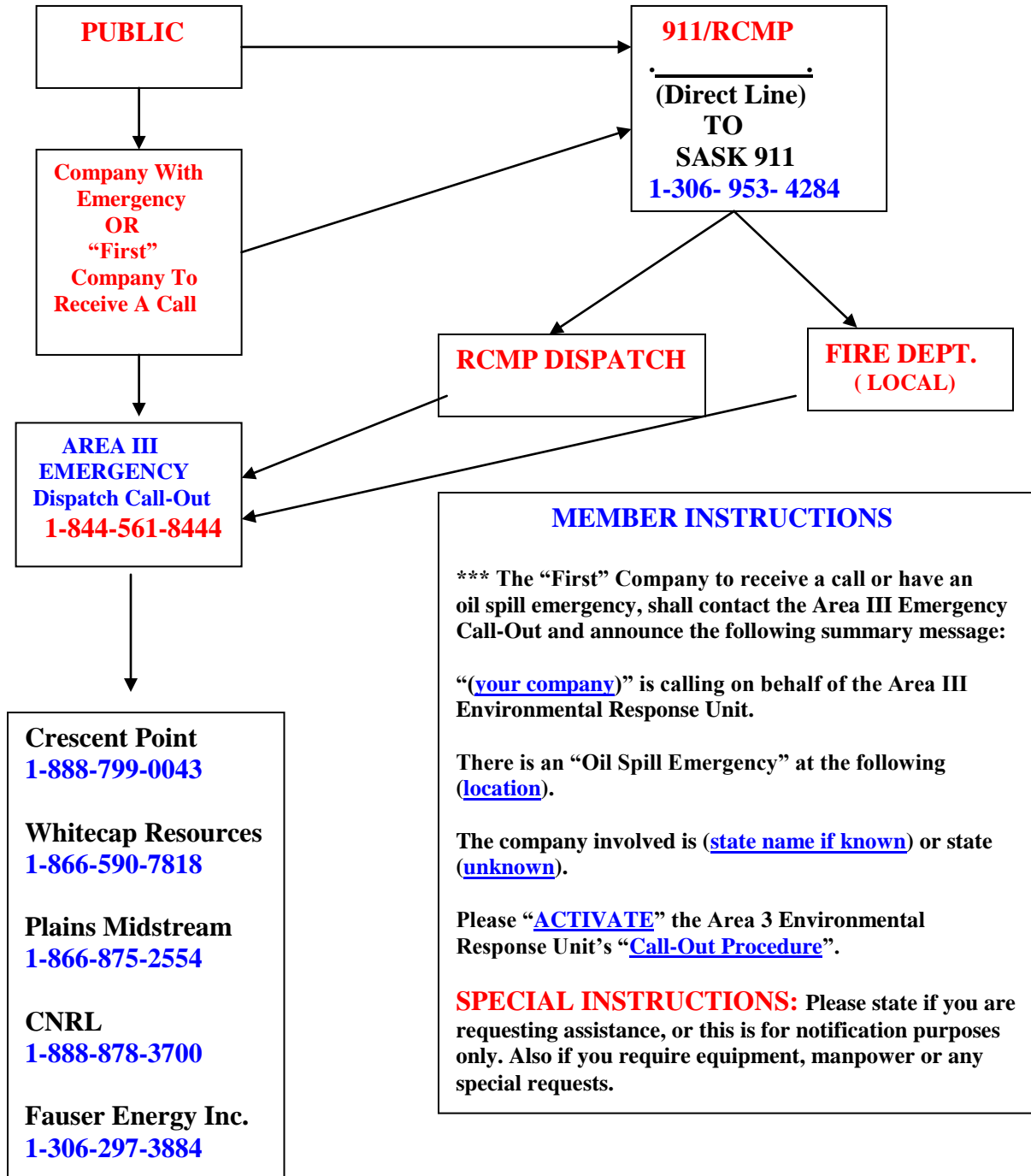


AREA 3 ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSE UNIT

Area 3 Environmental Response Unit

MANDATE: to provide expertise towards communication, training and contingency planning to minimize risks and environmental damage in the event of a major oil spill.

A pipeline emergency exists whenever the failure of a pipeline allows the escape of a liquid or gas which may end in an emergency:

1. The responsible pipeline company will:

- a) Detect and locate the pipeline leak and identify the escaping gas or liquid.
- b) Advise the appropriate public authorities and other concerned parties of the emergency.
- c) Take action to control the escape of the gas or liquid.
- d) Assist public authorities to safeguard the public and property.
- e) Remediate the impacted area and restore to its original state.

2. The Emergency Services will:

- a) Utilize the Area 3 ERU Call-Out procedure to inform companies with information about the release.
- b) Safeguard the public and evacuate people as necessary.
- c) Assist the pipeline company to clear hazardous conditions.
- d) Return people to the evacuated area once deemed safe.
- e) Assist other authorities in adjacent areas as necessary.
