AREA 3 ERU EQUIPMENT USE AGREEMENT

- **1.** Any company borrowing equipment from the Area 3 ERU response trailer must have the approval of the Steering Committee custodian, Fauser Energy (306.297.3884).
- **2**. The normal locations of the trailers are at Tervita's Facility at Gull Lake, Saskatchewan and Fauser Energy's shop located north of Shaunavon, Saskatchewan on the #37 highway.
- **3.** Transportation of the Area 3 ERU response trailer can be arranged through the custodian.
- **4.** Each company taking control of the Area 3 ERU response trailer for a given emergency is responsible to see that the equipment is cleaned properly and returned to its designated storage location as soon as possible after the emergency.
- **5.** The company taking control of the Area 3 ERU response trailer shall notify the custodian advising them that the equipment has been returned to its normal location following which the custodian will inspect the equipment. All costs will be charged directly to the company having used the equipment.
- 6. Motorized equipment will be serviced under the control of the custodian.
- **7.** Response trailer rental charges for Non-Members are as follows:
 - **a.** Daily rental will be \$3000.00/day for use of some or all of the equipment including the trailer.
 - **b.** Non-members are responsible and liable for any loss of equipment, clean up, and/or replacement at the Steering Committees recommendations.
 - c. Transportation cost is the responsibility of the user, charged through the custodian.

TRAILER EQUIPMENT POLICY

- Trailers and equipment must be used as a complete unit.
- The companies using the Area 3 ERU response trailer need to supply air compression and gasoline.
- This format shall be used until the emergency has ended and the trailer and equipment are no longer required and have been returned. At which time inspection and repair will be initiated by the Area 3 ERU custodian and the replacement policy takes effect.
- Companies using the Area 3 ERU response trailer are requested to return the trailer to the place of origin or hire the custodian to do so.
- The custodian will perform a final cleaning of the equipment, take inventory and insure the equipment is in working order.
- The company who used the equipment in the trailer shall be invoiced by the Area 3 ERU for any additional cleaning and replacement of missing or damaged equipment.
- The company should have a representative present for an inspection of the trailer and equipment upon return of the trailer to original site.
