OIL SPILL TRAINING GUIDELINES

1. **<u>Registration/Sign In</u>**: Companies are encouraged to send employees and contact personnel to the annual training programs.

a) Captains will be assigned to each position: Lake Boats and Motors, Lake Booms, Skimmer & Pumps and Pipeline, Safety Coordinator.

b) Employees will sign in and be assigned to a team. Employees will sign in when the exercise starts and out when the exercise is finished.

- 2. **<u>Commander/Coordinator</u>**: **MEET** at spill site and go over exercise details and procedures to be used for training exercise..
- 3. <u>**Commander**</u>(**Coordinator: MEET** with captains and safety coordinator to go over details of exercise.

<u>Commander</u> Coordinator: REVIEW safety procedures with safety coordinator.

- 4. **<u>Commander\Coordinator:</u>** ANNOUNCE the captains and teams and relay the details of the exercise to the captains and teams.
- 6. **<u>Commander/Coordinator:</u>** ANNOUNCE the safety coordinator.
- 5. **<u>Captains</u>**: **TOUR** trailer and equipment one team at a time.
- 6. <u>Commander\Coordinator, Captains:</u> REMOVE and SET UP equipment one team at a time and explain what it is used for starting with the :
 - 1. Boats and Motors
 - 2. Lake Booms
 - 3. Skimmer and Pumps
 - 4. Pipeline
- 7. **<u>Commander/Coordinator, Captain</u>**: **START** the water exercise.
- 8. **<u>Commander\Coordinator, Captain</u>**: **RETURN** equipment back to trailer starting with:
 - 1. Pipeline
 - 2. Skimmer and Pumps
 - 3. Lake Booms
 - 4. Boat and Motors
- 9. **<u>Commander/Coordinator, Captain:</u>** Coordinate site clean up.
- 10. **Safety Coordinator**: Look back on what went well and what needs to be improved.
